

Extending the Montney Fairway--North Montney Resource Play

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Unconventional Gas Resources (UGR) has been an active player in the Montney in northeastern British Columbia since 2008. We have an interest in 27 gross wells and currently hold 28,625 net hectares of land.

The Montney unconventional gas fairway extends northwest from the Alberta–BC border over a distance of approximately 325 km. The Montney fairway encompasses a much larger area than what was originally generally conceived. UGR lands are located in the northwest part of this trend, referred to as the North Montney. This area encompasses some of the best wells in the Montney fairway and has 3 distinct horizontal targets.

We will show how the Montney regional play has been delineated over the past 5 years. North Montney attributes will be compared with productive areas in the oldest developed fields on the eastern side of the play.

Discussion of the North Montney reservoir and production characteristics will include the following:

- geologic setting
- liquids trends
- pressure gradients
- comparison of log derived and core derived properties
- gas-in-place estimates, including free and sorbed phases
- well performance overview
