Progress to Revive Geoscience Innovation in Myanmar with Advanced Laboratory

ABSTRACT

After decades of delay, the process of establishing Myanmar Geosciences Institute with an advanced laboratory is in progress and government-academia-industry collaborated planning is gaining momentum to study areas once inaccessible both on-land and offshore. Focusing on missing areas for decades, marine geosciences and geohazard research will play key role of the new institute, while resources exploration and geotechnical engineering, and environmental geoscience are also included. In addition, advanced laboratory (National Analytical Laboratory-NAL) is in operation and servicing academia and government research.
