

OIL AND GAS SEEPS IN AND AROUND PESHAWAR AREA OF PAKISTAN

The Peshawar basin and its immediate surroundings give good indications of potential source of Hydrocarbon.

Based on the recent reported oil and gas seepage in the areas, surrounding Peshawar basin in the NWFP have given sufficient base for exploring the area for occurrences of its potential conducive environment for oil and gas occurrences.

Current report is an effort to indicate the known seep targets with a preliminary account on its occurrences and type of the seep.

With the follow up research and studies, it could serve as source of guidelines for conducting detail exploration and analysis of the area for its Hydrocarbon potential.
