

Look-out Below: Exploring Indonesia's Proven Basins

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ABSTRACT

Indonesia remains a key contributor to new discoveries in South East Asia, accounting for 30% of new hydrocarbon volumes over the last five years. Most of these new discoveries in Indonesia are in the proven basins which have infrastructure in place to support future development given growing domestic demand. This paper will review recent discoveries and play trends in these proven basins, to identify potential sources of the yet to find volumes. Analogue analysis using similar basins and plays in the region will be conducted to identify new plays/concepts which can be further investigated in future exploration. Lastly, this paper will review the track record of developing and bringing new fields onstream in these areas.
